Just As I Am

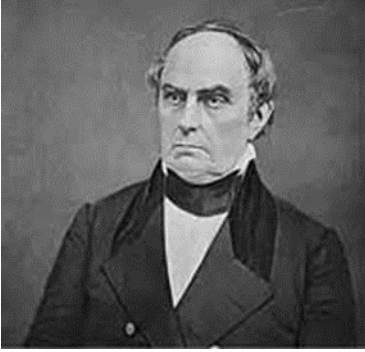
1 Just as I am, without one plea,

DANIEL WEBSTER was one of America's best-known statesmen and orators. From his career of brilliant oratory and ability to captivate audiences, many stories have been handed down concerning his words. It is worthy to note that he once said of himself, "If there is anything in my style or thoughts to be commended, the credit is due to my kind parents in instilling into my mind an early love for the Scriptures ."

He also said, "If we abide by the principles taught in the Bible, our country will prosper. But if we and our posterity neglect the instructions and authority in this Book, no man can tell how sudden a catastrophe may overtake us and bury our glory in profound obscurity."

"This is the Book that inspired thousands of men and women to travel to a New World where they could live and worship God in freedom. This is the Book our forefathers drew upon for the great principles included in the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution. This is the Book that the people of America, in every walk of life, have turned to for strength, for comfort and for guidance. This is the Book that is in every court of this broad land, a reminder of America's ideal of freedom and justice for all. This is the Book that its enemies burn. The Book they smear and fear, because it proclaims the dignity of the individual and teaches that all men are created in the image of God."

One time, it is told, he was asked what he regarded as the greatest thought that ever occupied his mind. He replied: **"The sense of my individual responsibility to God."**
